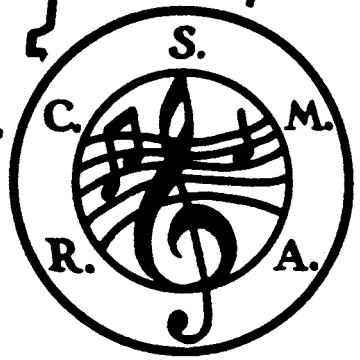

NOTES ON CONDUCTORS

JUNIOR CHORUS

Mr. Vredenburg is a graduate of the Crane School of Music, State University College at Potsdam, New York where he majored in Music Education, Voice, and Piano. His post-graduate education includes a Master's Degree in Curriculum & Instruction from the State University of New York in Albany and choral conducting seminars with Donald Neuen, Dale Warland, Robert Page, Gregg Smith, and Margaret Hillis. Mr. Vredenburg retired after 33 years as the Music Department Head at the Saratoga Springs City Schools where he taught Music Theory and directed three choruses in the high school. The Choraliers, his most select group, have received the highest ratings at NYSSMA competitions and national music festivals all along the eastern seaboard and in Canada. He has also been a guest conductor for Junior & Senior High School choral festivals and Area All-State festivals in New York State and Massachusetts and is a major organization judge for NYSSMA competitions. Currently, he is working for the Crane School of Music, State University College, Potsdam, New York as a college supervisor for the Capital District music student teachers.

Jeff lives in Saratoga Springs, New York with his wife, Brenda, who is our accompanist for this festival.

ELEMENTARY BAND

Marc Bachorik is an instrumental music teacher and department chairperson at the Cobleskill-Richmondville Central School District. He currently teaches two middle school bands, jazz ensemble, group lessons and general music. Mr. Bachorik completed his Bachelor's degree at the College of Saint Rose where he graduated magna cum laude. His Master's degree in Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment was obtained from Walden University in Minneapolis, Minnesota. Mr. Bachorik teaches private guitar and drum lessons to students at Backstreet Music in Cobleskill, New York. He is also the brass and woodwind instrument repairman for the store. Mr. Bachorik has played with the Diane Marlowe Big Band, The SUNY Cobleskill Jazz Ensemble and various pit orchestras including the Timothy Murphy Playhouse.

When Mr. Bachorik's dance band, Prolonged Exposure, is not playing gigs on the weekends, he likes to hang out with his family and watch cars go around in circles.

JAZZ CHORUS

Teresa Broadwell is a jazz vocalist, violinist, band leader and arranger. She is formally trained, holding a BA from the Crane School of Music, and a MA in Jazz Studies from the College of St. Rose. She started her professional music career while at the Crane School in the mid 1970's, playing a steady gig with a jam band at the Wild Oat bar in Potsdam, New York. Her first recording album "Sunny Side of the Street," was released in 1978 during a stint with the "New Moon Swing Band," a group devoted to 3-part vocalese and jump swing. During her tenure with "Doc Scanlon's Rhythm Boys," she was the featured vocalist, performing at concerts, festivals, radio and television shows, and jazz clubs in the greater Northeast. In the 1980's she went on to form her own groups featuring her vocal and swing fiddle talents. In addition to her own ensembles, she continues to perform with the vocal harmony group "Jazz Voices".

Teresa has performed with and/or opened concerts for musical luminaries such as Stan Getz, Jon Hendricks, Marc O'Connor; Asleep at the Wheel; Leon Redbone, violinist Matt Glaser, and baritone sax great Nick Brignola. She has performed at musical hotspots including Jazzmania in New York City; the Cellar Door in Washington DC; Ryles in Cambridge MA; Sandy's Jazz Revival Bar in Beverly MA; the Van Dyke in Schenectady NY; and Red Creek in Rochester, NY. She was also featured with her group the New Moon Swing Band on Garrison Keillor's Prairie Home Companion radio show. Teresa's latest recording "Everything's Jake" (available on Riff Records) features her swing band Thirvin' on A Riff. In addition to her performing schedule, Teresa currently directs the vocal jazz ensemble and teaches jazz voice and violin at the College of St. Rose in Albany, NY.

SENIOR BAND

Christopher David Neubert is currently in his third season as conductor of the University at Albany Symphony Orchestra. In addition to his position at the university, Mr. Neubert serves on the Adjunct Faculty at The College of Saint Rose, where he serves as a member of the String Education faculty, Professor of Double Bass, and has conducted both the College Chamber Orchestra and Wind Ensemble during the spring of 2010.

Having recently retired from serving as Director of Music for the Niskayuna Schools, and thirty-five years in public school music in New York, Neubert remains active as a New York State School Music (NYSSMA) All-State and Major Organization Adjudicator, and guest conducts a variety of band and orchestra festivals throughout the Northeast.

Mr. Neubert earned his Bachelor's in Music Education from West Chester University and a Master of Music degree from Ithaca College. Early conducting study was with Jacques Voois, Tibor Puszta, John Paynter and Frederick Fennell. The School of Education of Long Island University has recognized Neubert as one of their Outstanding Graduates in Educational Administration.

Neubert maintains The Neubert Studio in Saratoga Springs, where students study violin, viola, cello and double bass in preparation for careers in both educational and performance music.
