NOTES ON CONDUCTORS

ELEMENTARY BAND - Robert Bennett currently teaches two elementaryband programs in the Troy City School District. A graduate of Columbia High School in East Greenbush, NY, Mr. Bennett holds a Bachelor's Degree in Music Education from the Crane School of Music at SUNY Potsdam where he performed and conducted in virtually every venue at the school, ranging from Symphony Orchestra and Chamber Choir to Jazz Ensemble. He has appeared as a guest conductor with the Crane Symphony Orchestra, Sachem East Wind Ensemble, Troy All-City Wind Ensemble, Troy Summer Music Concert Band, Crane Youth Music Wind Ensemble, and many others. In addition, he is in demand as a freelance trombonist, with appearances with Keith Pray's Big Soul Ensemble, Schenectady Symphony Orchestra, The Refrigerators, Wally Siebel's All-Star Big Band, Saratoga Polo Orchestra, NitroJive, The Hackensack Men to name a few. On stage, he has appeared with such luminaries as Hubert Laws, Stefon Harris, Byron Stripling, Bret Zvacek, Gene Bertocini, and has also worked with the likes of world-renown violinist Pinchas Zukerman and Montreal Symphony Orchestra Principal Trombonist James Box. Mr. Bennett has performed and conducted both domestically and internationally, including appearances in New York, Montreal, Ottawa, Chicago, Quebec, Cleveland, Zurich, and in such venues as Carnegie Hall, Tanglewood, the National Arts Centre, and many colleges and universities.

JUNIOR CHORUS - David Rossi received his education at Hartwick College where he studied music education with a concentration in voice and conducting with Dr. Jirka Kratochvíl. He is currently a music teacher in the Schenectady City School District. He has previously worked in Germantown Central School District as well as Notre Dame-Bishop Gibbons High School. Mr. Rossi has sung with and conducted choirs and ensembles throughout the Central and Capital Regions of New York State. He currently conducts the Mohawk Valley Chorus, Clifton Park Community Chorus, and St. Clare's Choraliers. Mr. Rossi has also served as a music director for the Spotlight Players and Not So Common Players. In 2009 he was received a TANYS award for his work on the Not So Common Players production of *Godspell*. Additionally, Mr. Rossi is the music director at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church.

JAZZ CHORUS – Laura Osgood received her B.M. in music education and performance from the Crane School of Music in Potsdam, NY where she studied both voice and harp. She completed her student teaching in Canton, NY, directing the mixed, select, and jazz choirs under the tutelage of Mrs. Kimberly Busch. She went on to hold the position of music director for the Golden Knotes a capella choir of Clarkson University, and then spent several months teaching middle school general music in Churchville Chili, NY. She has also been on the

faculty of Belvoir Terrace, a fine and performing arts camp for girls, for 4 years as a voice teacher and choral director. She is now finishing her M.M. at the College-Conservatory of Music of the University of Cincinnati, and enjoys positions singing in the Old Saint Mary's Church quintet, specializing in medieval motets, and as a singing server at Vito's Café of Fort Thomas, KY.

SENIOR BAND - Michael C. Patrizio received his BS and MS degrees in music education from the College of St. Rose. He is a recent retiree of the North Colonie Central School District after 37 years of service. He began his career as an assistant high school band director at Shaker High School in 1972. In 1974, he became the elementary band director at several of the North Colonie Schools for 19 years. He initiated both the North Colonie summer music program and the elementary 4th grade band programs. In 1993 he became the Shaker High School band director and initiated the level VI Wind Ensemble program; Shaker High School " Principals' Own" marching band and flute choir. He led the Shaker High Jazz Ensemble for 16 years which was very active in the community performing at fund raising and other charitable events. Today he is very proud of the large number of former students who were inspired to become music teachers themselves and are teaching in our area schools. He is excited to return to his elementary band roots as conductor today and is quoted as saying upon acceptance of this position " I can't wait to work again with those little tigers !"
