NOTES ON CONDUCTORS

ELEMENTARY BAND

Andrew Janack received a Master of Music degree from the University of Connecticut, Storrs, Connecticut, a Bachelor of Music degree from The Crane School of Music, Potsdam, New York, and an Associate of Science degree from Schenectady County Community College, Schenectady, New York. He is a freelance percussionist and drum set artist in the Capital Region of New York and Western Massachusetts. He has performed with the Albany, Berkshire, and Schenectady Symphonies, and is currently a member of The Capital Region Wind Ensemble. He has also played percussion for several Broadway national tours at Proctors Theatre in Schenectady, New York including West Side Story and most recently Cinderella.

Mr. Janack is a band director in the Saratoga Springs City School District in Saratoga Springs, New York. He currently teaches Concert Band and Symphonic Band at Saratoga Springs High School and 8th Grade Band at Maple Avenue Middle School. He is also an adjunct faculty member teaching percussion and percussion ensembles at Schenectady County Community College and at Castleton University.

Mr. Janack has been a guest conductor for festivals in Saratoga-Warren, Columbia, and Greene counties as well as for the Colonial Council Music Festival and He has also conducted festivals in Western Massachusetts.

TREBLE CHOIR

Penny Schiek is well known in the Glens Falls, NY area as a choral director, mezzo-contralto soloist, voice teacher and handbell director. She grew up in the western Finger Lakes region of New York State and received her music education degrees from the Crane School of Music at SUNY Potsdam and Bowling Green State University, Ohio.

Ms. Schiek recently retired from NYS public school music education after 32 years of service to the districts of Penn Yan, Whitehall and most recently, Queensbury. She is currently the director of handbells at Christ Church United Methodist in Glens Falls, a voice adjudicator for the NYS School Music Association (NYSSMA), music director of The Adirondack Voices, a 90 voice community choir in the Glens Falls area, and the music director for the newly formed Saratoga Veterans A Cappella Chorus.

Ms. Schiek's guest conducting includes the Burlington Madrigal Festival sponsored by the American Choral Director's Association as well as several All-County Choruses across NYS and Messiah performances with orchestra in Rutland, VT and Glens Falls. In addition, she has prepped choruses for, or conducted, Bach's St. John Passion in 2004 with the Glens Falls Symphony, an epic performance in 2009 of Verdi's Requiem with over 200 participating musicians, and a spectacular performance in 2016 of Belshazzar's Feast with the Glens Falls Symphony under Simon Carrington.

Her choruses have been heard throughout the northeast, the Bahamas and Europe, and several of her students have pursued successful careers in music and the arts. She has been named to Who's Who Among American Teachers, and is a current member of NYSSMA and the National Association for Music Education.

Her retirement hobbies include motorcycle touring, golf and travel.

STRING ORCHESTRA

Brian Austin is in his twenty eighth year of teaching in the North Colonie School District 18 of those at the Junior High level and the past 10 as Director of Orchestra at Shaker High School. Brian received a Bachelor of Music Education from the Crane School of Music and a Masters in Education from SUNY Albany.

As director of the Shaker High School Orchestras, Mr. Austin's groups have received the highest honor at NYSSMA Majors, performing at level 6 with a rating of Gold with Distinction. The orchestras have also traveled on numerous occasions to perform and have received highest commendations from adjudicators at those festivals.

JUNIOR CHORUS

Sara Pabis is from Weedsport, NY. She earned a Bachelors of Science in Music Education, concentration in Voice from the College of Saint Rose in 2010, and a Masters of Music from SUNY Potsdam in 2012. She is currently the Middle and High School vocal music and theater teacher at Ogdensburg Free Academy in Ogdensburg, NY. She also directs the school's musicals and Select Choir. Sara resides with her husband and dog in Canton, NY.

SENIOR BAND

Jonathan Pabis grew up in the Finger Lakes Region of New York. He attended The Crane School of Music at SUNY Potsdam where he received a Bachelors in Music Education and later a Masters in Music Education. Directly after graduation from his undergraduate studies, Jonathan spent time living and working in London, England. Upon returning to the United States, Jonathan settled down in Canton, NY, where he currently resides with his wife Sara. Jonathan has taught in St. Lawrence County for almost a decade and is currently the 7-12 Instrumental Music teacher at Norwood-Norfolk Central School. During his time teaching in St. Lawrence County, Jonathan has directed an All-County Band, chaired for All-County Festivals and served a term as the Vice President of the St. Lawrence Music Educators Association. He has also performed with the Northern Symphonic Winds and is an active member of the Potsdam Community Band.
