NOTES ON CONDUCTORS**JUNIOR BAND**

Tim Powhida - After Graduating from the Crane School of Music in 2001, Mr. Powhida began his Master's program at SUNY Potsdam. Graduating in May of 2003 with an MST in Education he began his search for a job. As luck would have it, South Glens Falls was hiring and within two weeks of graduation he found himself employed and ready to take on the challenges of the music classroom. Mr. Powhida is currently a Band and Elementary Music teacher in the South Glens Falls Central School District.

Fast forward sixteen years and Mr. Powhida is still loving the classroom. He finds many

opportunities to hone his skills as a musician as well. Mr. Powhida plays in the Lake George Community Band and sits as principal Euphonium. He has served on the board of Directors for the band as President, Vice President and Trustee.

Summer of 2018 was unforgettable for Mr. Powhida who also plays the snare drum with the Galloway Gaelic Pipe and Drum Band. The Band is located in South Glens Falls and has a parade division and a competition division. The competition band performed at seven competitions over the summer this year. Placing first in four of the competitions and second in another earned the band the honor of being named the North Eastern United States Pipe Band Champions for Grade Five Bands.

ELEMENTARY CHORUS

Tiffany Dzembo is currently the Director of Curriculum at Heatly School in Green Island, NY where she previously served as the sole PreK-12 Music Teacher for twelve years. At Heatly, she taught General Music, Class Piano, Elementary Chorus, Junior-High Chorus, and a college level Rock History class through Hudson Valley Community College. JAZZ ENSEMBLE

Jonathan Hunkins is currently the Music Department Chairman and Director of Bands at the Massena Central High School where his responsibilities include the high school concert band, marching band, jazz ensemble, pep band, percussion ensemble and music theory. A 1992 graduate of Ithaca College, Mr. Hunkins earned a B.M. degree with high honors double majoring in Music Education and Music Performance with a percussion concentration. Mr. Hunkins later completed his M.S. degree with honors in Music Education from the Crane School of Music, SUNY at Potsdam, NY in 1996.

Mr. Hunkins frequently performs throughout the North Country as a percussionist including such groups as the Orchestra of Northern NY, Northern Symphonic Winds and the Norwood Brass Fireman since 1985. Mr. Hunkins also frequently guest conducts both concert bands and jazz ensembles around NYS including the St. Lawrence Counties High School and Junior High All-County ensembles as well as the St. Lawrence Valley Leagues Jazz Ensemble and Concert Bands. BOE for the Norwood-Norfolk Central School District as well as sitting on the board for the Norwood Village Green Concert Series. Mr. Hunkins is also an extremely active clinician in the areas of conducting, percussion, and technology throughout the North Country.

Mr. Hunkins was an original member of the “The Conrad Story Blues Band” playing drums as well as serving as the recording engineer and producer for their recording projects. He currently performs with various other groups throughout the North Country including “The Debt” and “Plan B”.

BRASS ENSEMBLE

Robert J. Allen is currently in his 19th year of teaching, and currently is the 7-12 Band Director at Hoosick Falls Central School. Previously he held positions as a band director and general music teacher at Clifton-Fine Central School and as an Adjunct Professor at The Crane School of Music at SUNY Potsdam and Northeastern Baptist College. He is the recipient of the 2014 Teachers of Excellence Award from Senator Kathleen Marchione, and also was selected for the 2013 CASDA Scholars' Recognition Program.

He has directed and accompanied numerous All County ensembles, and has also served as director and musical directed over a dozen high school drama productions. He lives in Hoosick Falls with his wife Heather of 14 years and his four amazing children, where he currently serves as Mayor of the Village of Hoosick Falls.

Danielle Cornacchio - Originally from Shirley, NY, Danielle Cornacchio received her bachelor's degree in music education, with a secondary concentration in Vocal Performance, from the Crane School of Music at the State University of New York at Potsdam in 2007.
