NOTES ON CONDUCTORS

ELEMENTARY CHORUS

Dr. Michael C. Lister is currently the Chair of the Music Department at the College of Saint Rose, where he conducts several choral ensembles and teaches courses in conducting, and music education. He holds degrees from Mount Vernon Nazarene University, Indiana University, and Ball State University, where he received a Doctor of Arts degree in Choral Conducting. For six years, Dr. Lister was the Director of Choirs at Cuyahoga Valley Christian Academy in Ohio. He has served as guest clinician, conductor and adjudicator for various festivals and events for NYSSMA and other organizations. In addition to serving as of the board of the New York state chapter of the American Choral Directors Association, Dr. Lister maintains active membership in numerous organizations, including the National Association for Music Education, and the College Music Society. Dr. Lister currently serves as the Music Director of First Presbyterian Church in Albany, New York.

JAZZ BAND

Joe North is a freelance tenor saxophonist in the Hudson Valley, performing in diverse ensembles from chamber ensembles to funk bands. North is also the Director of bands at Poughkeepsie High School as well as an adjunct teacher at Dutchess Community College. He has a bachelor's degree in Music Education from SUNY Fredonia and a masters degree in jazz studies from the University of the Arts in Philadelphia PA. This is North's first time conducting an All County Band is is excited to be working with the students!

SENIOR CHORUS

Mrs. Kathleen Washburn McCarty (originally from Gansevoort, NY and a graduate of the South Glens Falls School District), holds a Bachelor's of Music Degree in Education from the Crane School of Music at Potsdam, NY with a concentration in voice and a Master's Degree from Plattsburgh State University. Kathleen has been employed as a Secondary Music Educator with the Saratoga Springs City School District since 1990. Prior to that time she also taught at Schroom Lake Central School and Granville Jr/Sr High School. She is the Director of The Saratoga Springs High School Choraliers as well as other vocal ensembles. The Choraliers perform annually in National Music Festival Competitions and receive Superior Ratings. She is also the organist and soloist for Sanford's Ridge UMC & Organist and Choir Director for the Fort Edward Village Baptist Church.

Kathleen is a past member of the Adirondack Voices, served as its Director, and is a past president of the organization. She also served as rehearsal director for the Mastersingers for 4 years and was a founding member of that organization and conducts at other area All-County Festivals.

A pianist as well as vocalist, Kathleen is a member of NYSSMA, NAFME, and ACDA and has chaired the NYSSMA Zone 7 Area All-State Festivals in the past. She also chairs the Zone 7 Area All-State Chorus. Kathleen is an active member of SWCMEA and the Albany Pro Musica Masterworks. She has been involved with other various local performing organizations including: Albany Pro Musica, Lake George Opera Festival, Saratoga Chorale, and Schuylerville Community Theater.

Kathleen is also the wife of R. Paul McCarty (retired teacher/administrator of Saratoga Springs City School District), Town & Village Historian of Fort Edward, NY and the Executive Director of the Old Fort House Museum, and the mother of Robert P. McCarty, Esq. They reside in the village of Fort Edward, NY.

JUNIOR BAND

Scott Andrews is currently in his second year of retirement after teaching instrumental music in the Ravena-Coeymans-Selkirk Central School District for 34 years. Mr. Andrews taught instrumental music, band and jazz ensemble at RCS for 23 years in the middle school before moving to the high school where he was director of the high school concert band and jazz ensemble for 11 years. He also served as the K-12 District Music Coordinator for 13 years.

Mr. Andrews has conducted at festivals in Albany, Greene, Rensselaer, Columbia, Schoharie and Hamilton counties. A native of Columbia County, he graduated from Hudson High School in 1978. He received his Bachelors Degree (1982) and his Masters Degree (1986) in music education from The College Of Saint Rose in Albany, graduating with academic honors.

During his 11 years at RCS High School, his concert bands consistently performed well at NYSSMA Major Organization Festivals, receiving 6 Gold with Distinction awards and 5 Gold awards at NYSSMA level 4.

From 1982-86, Mr. Andrews directed the Siena College Jazz Ensemble, where one of his group's performances in 1984, was voted by local media as one of the top ten jazz performances of the year for both professional and amateur jazz groups in the Capital Region.

Mr. Andrews is an active member and participant in the activities of the New York State School Music Association, currently serving as a NYSSMA solo festival adjudicator and Music In Our Schools Month chairperson.

Outside of teaching, Mr. Andrews has maintained an active performance schedule as a saxophonist and clarinetist. He has performed in several commercial bands, jazz bands and as a freelance musician throughout the Capital District and Northeast Region for over 40 years.
