NOTES ON CONDUCTORS

ELEMETARY BAND

Joshua Thompson is currently on applied faculty for Castleton University and is an artist in residence at Hartwick College in Oneonta, New York. He completed graduate and post-graduate study in performance at the Hartt School, where he studied with Daniel Grabois and David Wakefield, respectively. He completed undergraduate study at the College of Saint Rose, where he studied horn with Patrice Malatestinic.

He has performed with several ensembles and organizations across the Northeast, including: Albany Pro Musica, Battenkill Chorale, Berkshire Symphony, Hartford Independent Chamber Orchestra, Hubbard Hall Opera Theatre, Park Playhouse (Albany, NY), Schenectady Symphony and West Hartford Symphony. He is the 2011 winner of the solo completion at the Northeast Horn Workshop. He has guest conducted several honor bands throughout the region, including those for the Fulton and Montgomery All-County Music Festivals.

As an advocate for music in our communities, Joshua is the director of Gloversville Community Music. There he maintains a private teaching studio, directs the Glove City Winds and organizes workshops and performances.

JUNIOR CHORUS

Mrs. Alexis Bresnahan is a 2006 and 2007 graduate of the Crane School of Music at SUNY Potsdam. She holds both Bachelors and Masters Degrees in Music Education, with a concentration in Voice. While at SUNY Potsdam, Mrs. Bresnahan was active as a student conductor of womens and mixed choirs at the collegiate level mentored by Dr. Rebecca Reames.

Mrs. Bresnahan has taught in the Millbrook Central School District (Dutchess County, NY) since September of 2007, where she currently teaches general music and choirs at the middle and high school levels. Her students are frequently selected for the Elementary All-County, Junior High All-County, Area All-State and Conference All-State choirs, as well as the NY-ACDA Middle School Honor Choir. Under her direction, the Millbrook choirs have received superior ratings at adjudication.

Mrs. Bresnahan is a member of the American Choral Directors Association (ACDA), the National Association for Music Education (MENC), the Dutchess County Music Educators Association (DCMEA) and the New York State School Music Association (NYSSMA). Mrs. Bresnahan also serves as the director of the Millbrook Middle and High School Drama Clubs and is a member of the New York State Theatre Educators' Association (NYSTEAA).

Chelsea Reeves is a teacher at the Ballston Spa Central School District. She has been at Ballston Spa for 8 years, and loves teaching strings and conducting orchestras for grades 6 through 12. A former member of the Crossmen Drum and Bugle Corps, Mr. Vitale continued in the drum corps activity serving as a visual instructor with the Crossmen, Jersey Surf, Hawthorne Caballeros, and is currently the Visual Caption Head with DCA's World Champion Reading Buccaneers Drum and Bugle Corps. Mr. Vitale is also an active visual designer for several high school bands in Delaware, New Jersey, Maryland, Pennsylvania, and Virginia. As the Director of Bands at Westfield High School, Mr. Vitale oversees eight Performing Ensembles, which includes three concert bands, two jazz ensembles, a percussion ensemble, indoor color guard, and the award winning Marching Blue Devils. Under his direction the WHS Bands have consistently received superior ratings and top honors at regional and state festivals. The Wind Ensemble has received a Gold Rating at the CJMEA Concert Band Festival every year since his arrival in 2011. In March of 2014, the WHS Wind Ensemble performed in the National Band and Orchestra Festival held at acclaimed Avery Fisher Hall, located in New York City's Lincoln Center and in April of 2015 the WHS Bands gave a performance tour of Austria and the Czech Republic. His professional affiliations include the National Band Association, the National Association For Music Education, the New Jersey Music Educators Association, and the Central Jersey Music Educators Association.
