NOTES ON CONDUCTORS

ELEMENTARY BAND

Michael Silvagnoli was born in Brooklyn and raised on Long Island. He attended the Crane School of Music at the State University of New York at Potsdam where he received both his Bachelor's and Master's in Music Education with a concentration in tuba. Michael has been a 6th, 7th, and 8th grade band director in the Shenendehowa Central School District since 2003. Additionally, Michael has been affiliated with Skidmore College as lecturer of tuba since 2007 where he has taught tuba lessons and participated in festivals and ensembles. Michael would like to thank his colleagues, students, parents, and fiancée Leia for their support.

JUNIOR CHORUS

Frank Leavitt has degrees in Music Education from the Crane School of Music (SUNY Potsdam) and the University of Connecticut. He has studied conducting with Brock McElheran, Stanley Chapple, Calvin Gage and Peter Bagley. He has sung in choirs conducted by some of the greatest conductors in history, including Robert Shaw, Leonard Bernstein, and Eugene Ormandy; he counts himself honored and fortunate to be a member of Albany Pro Musica, singing under David Griggs-Janower.

While he has lately become very active in the world of theater, singing remains his favorite art, and the most powerful expression of his soul. Long before his 13 years teaching music in the Bethlehem Central Schools (Delmar), and long after, the singular love of his life has been teaching. It is a tremendous honor to be able to combine his love of music and his love of teaching in working with these talented young people, and he thanks the Rensselaer County Music Association for giving him the opportunity.

JAZZ CHORUS

Teresa Broadwell, jazz vocalist, violinist, band leader and arranger, holds a BA from the Crane School of Music, and an MA in Jazz Studies from the College of St. Rose; however, her real musical identity was nurtured by listening to and learning from the giants of jazz. Her vocal influences include: Lambert, Hendricks and Ross; Eddie Jefferson; King Pleasure; Sarah Vaughan; Betty Carter; Ella Fitzgerald; and Anita O'Day. On fiddle, she draws from Stuff Smith, Joe Venuti, Matt Glaser, and Stephan Grappelli.

She started her professional music career while at the Crane School of Music in the mid 1970's, playing a steady gig with a jam band at the Wild Oat bar in Potsdam, New York. This marked the beginning of her musical journey that has straddled the jazz and legit music worlds. After receiving her Bachelor's degree she pursued an ambitious performing schedule with a variety of jazz and roots music bands touring the Midwest and Northeast.

Her first recording album (yes, it was vinyl), "Sunny Side of the Street," was released in 1978 during a stint with the "New Moon Swing Band," a group devoted to 3-part vocalese

and jump swing. During her tenure with “Doc Scanlon’s Rhythm Boys,” she was the featured vocalist, performing at concerts, festivals, radio and television shows, and jazz clubs in the greater Northeast. In the 1980’s she went on to form her own groups featuring her vocal and swing fiddle talents. In addition to her own ensembles, she continues to perform with the vocal harmony group “Jazz Voices” along with fellow jazz vocalists Jody Shane and Colleen Pratt.

Teresa has performed with and/or opened concerts for musical luminaries such as Stan Getz, Jon Hendricks, Marc O’Connor; Asleep at the Wheel; Leon Redbone, violinist Matt Glaser, and baritone sax great Nick Brignola. She has performed at musical hotspots including Jazzmania in New York City; the Cellar Door in Washington DC; Ryles in Cambridge MA; Sandy’s Jazz Revival Bar in Beverly MA; the Van Dyke in Schenectady NY; and Red Creek in Rochester, NY. She was also featured with her group the New Moon Swing Band on Garrison Keillor’s Prairie Home Companion radio show.

Teresa’s CD, “Everything’s Jake” (available on Riff Records) features her swing band Thrivin’ on A Riff. In addition to her performing schedule, Teresa currently teaches strings in the Niskayuna Central School district, and string techniques at the College of St. Rose in Albany, NY.

SENIOR BAND

Norin Lavender earned his BFA in Percussion Performance at Purchase College in 1995. Before and after graduating, he worked as a freelance musician accompanying modern dance classes at Purchase College, Manhattanville College, the Steffi Nossen School of Dance, and for the Jose Limon dance company. Additionally, he performed with a number of bands, including HDT, who appeared on MTV’s Oddville and co-created a national live-advertising campaign for Seagram Americas.

In 1997, Norin began playing percussion and keyboards for the off-Broadway show Tap Dogs at Union Square Theatre in Manhattan. After a few weeks the show went on the road and for the next three years, toured North America, Europe, and Asia.

By 2000, Norin was back in the states and started working on his Master of Music Education degree at SUNY Potsdam. In September 2002, Norin began his teaching career at Clinton Middle School as the band instructor for grades 6-8. He currently directs two middle school bands and the high school symphonic band. Norin is also the director of the MS and HS jazz bands, assistant director for the MS musical, and the conductor of the HS musical pit orchestra.

Outside of school, Norin enjoys performing with the Rome Concert Band, the Orchestra of Northern New York, fusion group the DangLav Trio, blues keyboardist Al Nathan, and a variety of musicals for local high schools, colleges, and theater groups.
