NOTES ON CONDUCTORS

JAZZ ENSEMBLE

Ben O'Shea is an active trombonist and educator in the Capital Region. He currently teaches music in the Schenectady City School District while maintaining a private studio and performing regularly. He has directed and coached a number of jazz combos and big bands in addition to teaching for two years at Central Washington University in Ellensburg, Washington.

As a performer, Mr. O'Shea has shared the stage with many well-known artists including, Johnny Mathis, Linda Ronstadt, Leslie Uggams, Bobby Rydell, the Temptations, Ernestine Anderson, Jimmy Heath, Conrad Herwig, the Jimmy Dorsey Orchestra, and the Tucson Symphony Orchestra. He also toured across the United States for nearly two years as a member of the band with the Ringling Brothers Circus. Lately, he has been performing regularly with several local groups that include Sensemaya, Keith Pray's Big Soul Ensemble, the Joey Thomas Big Band as well as in venues such as Proctors Theater and Capital Repertory Theater. Mr. O'Shea holds degrees from the University of Arizona, Central Washington University, and the College of St. Rose. He is a native of Seattle, Washington and is proud to call the Capital Region home.

ELEMENTARY CHORUS

Shannon deFrancqueville has been teaching chorus and general music at Farnsworth Middle School in Guilderland for seven years. She attended The College of St. Rose in Albany, NY where she pursued a Bachelor's Degree in Music Education. She earned a Master's Degree in Music Education with an emphasis in pedagogy from the Hartt School of Music in Hartford, CT. She maintains a private vocal studio of 15 students in the summer. Shannon brings her chorus to NYS-SMA competition where she has received Gold ratings. Select students from her chorus participate every year in the American Choral Directors Association's New York State Honor Choir. She has been a featured soprano soloist for the Treble Choraliers in Catskill, NY and she enjoys playing tenor saxophone and singing in her rock band.

ORCHESTRA

David Bebe is an Assistant Professor of Music at the College of Saint Rose where he serves as the Conductor of the Saint Rose Orchestra, String Coordinator, and Cello Instructor. He received his D.M.A in Instrumental Performance from the University of Miami and his B.M. and M.M. from Indiana University.

As a string pedagogue, Dr. Bebe has been on the faculties of the Indiana University String Academy, the String Academy of Wisconsin at the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee, the Young Musicians and Artists Festival in Oregon, and the Gem State String Boot Camp at Idaho State University. His Doctoral Essay, "A Logical and Comprehensive Sequence of Skills for Teaching Young Children the Cello" includes a cello method and website.

While in Miami, Dr. Bebe gave the Florida premiere of Steve Reich's Cello Counterpoint with the composer present at his 75th Birthday Celebration. He was a soloist with the Miami Bach Society Orchestra and a featured chamber musician for Project Copernicus, the National Foundation for the Advancement of the Arts, and Festival Miami. He served as Associate Conductor for the Frost Symphony Orchestra and was appointed the Broward Symphony Orchestra's Guest Conductor in the spring of 2009. In March of 2010, Dr. Bebe took members of the Saint Rose Orchestra to perform in Avery Fisher Hall at the Lincoln Center for the Performing Arts in New York City.

SENIOR CHORUS

Michael C. Lister holds a Doctor of Arts degree in Choral Conducting at Ball State University, a Bachelor of Arts in Piano Performance from Mount Vernon Nazarene University, and a Master of Music in Music Theory from Indiana University. For six years, Dr. Lister was the Director of Choirs at Cuyahoga Valley Christian Academy, a private junior high and high school in Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio. He has also served on the faculty of Otterbein College in Westerville, Ohio, and Butler University in Indianapolis, Indiana. Dr. Lister is currently Assistant Professor of Choral Music at the College of Saint Rose, where he conducts several choral ensembles and teaches courses in conducting, education, and music theory. Dr. Lister currently serves as the Music Director of First Presbyterian Church in Albany, New York.

Throughout his career, Dr. Lister has remained an active conductor, clinician, and performer. He has served as Guest Conductor for numerous All County Festivals and the 2010 Area 6 All State Treble Chorus. Recent vocal performances include Mendelssohn's *Lobegesang* with the Loudonville Festival Celebration Choir, Loudonville, and *Lauda Sion* in Troy and Albany. Dr. Lister also performs regularly with the Choir of Men and Boys at the Cathedral of All Saints, Albany. In addition to serving as College and University Repertoire and Standards Chair for the New York American Choral Directors Association, Dr. Lister maintains active membership in numerous organizations, including the National Association for Music Education, Intercollegiate Men's Choruses, and the College Music Society, for which he is the College of Saint Rose Campus Representative.

JUNIOR BAND

Scott Severance received his Bachelor of Music degree from the Crane School of Music in 1981, and his Master's of Science degree from the University of Illinois in 1984. He has been employed by the Glens Falls City School District since 1981, where he currently teaches high school band, jazz ensemble, and lessons.

Scott resides in Queensbury NY with his wife Connie Freebern, who is also a band teacher in the Glens Falls District, together with their daughters Kate, currently a senior at Bryn Mawr College, and Clare, a sophomore at Queensbury High School. Their extended family also includes Foo Foo the rabbit and Cooper the greatest dog in the world.
