NOTES ON CONDUCTORS

ORCHESTRA

David Beck has been working as a string specialist for the Bethlehem Central School District since 1991. In addition to teaching string students in grades 6 through 12, Mr. Beck established a high school string chamber music program. He is currently the Conductor of the High School's Orchestra and Symphony, both consistent award winners. His chamber ensembles have performed at the Governor's Mansion and in master classes for the Manhattan String Quartet. An active performer and teacher, he has also worked as a festival clinician throughout New York, Connecticut, and Florida. Since 1995 he has been a conductor of orchestras at the Eastern U.S. Music Camp in Hamilton, NY. He received his Bachelor's in Music from Ithaca College, where he was a double major on cello and tuba, and a Master's degree in orchestral conducting from the Hartt School of Music. Mr. Beck has been the Empire State Youth Orchestra Repertory Orchestra Conductor since March 2000.

SENIOR CHORUS

Jeffrey Vredenburg is a graduate of the Crane School of Music, State University College at Potsdam, New York where he majored in Music Education, Voice and Piano. His post-graduate education includes a Master's Degree in Curriculum and Instruction from the State University of New York in Albany and choral conducting seminars with Donald Neuen, Dale Warland, Robert Page, Gregg Smith and Margaret Hillis. Mr. Vredenburg retired after 33 years as the Music Department Head at the Saratoga Springs City Schools where he taught Music Theory and directed three choruses in the high school. The Choraliers, his most select group, have received the highest ratings at NYSSMA competitions and national music festivals all along the eastern seaboard and in Canada. He has also been a guest conductor for Junior and Senior High School choral festivals and Area All-State festivals in New York State and

Massachusetts and is a major organization judge for NYSSMA competitions. Currently, he is working for the Crane School of Music, State University College, Potsdam, New York as a college supervisor for the Capital District music student teachers. Jeff lives in Saratoga Springs, New York with his wife, Brenda, who is our accompanist for this festival.

JAZZ ENSEMBLE

Kevin Hendrick started on piano at the age of 6. Drilled in music theory from an early age, he began studying the trumpet at age 10 and was playing bass in original and cover bands by age 14. Since graduating from The College of St. Rose (Albany, NY - '91) with a B.S. in Music Ed. (Trumpet) he has continued to play in a number of groups on Trumpet, Bass and Keyboards, has played in the pits for musical productions, has performed internationally on various cruise ships, and has taught Instrumental Music in schools and privately. His compositions and arrangements have reached the Latin charts several times, have been nominated for Grammy Awards, have been featured in motion pictures and television, and are performed by groups throughout the US. Kevin currently plays Trumpet for Central NY's Soul Injection, and freelances on trumpet, bass and keyboards. He is the brass instructor/director for Capital Brass and Brass-O-Mania (strolling Big Band) and also leads his own Latin Jazz group known as The Bartlett St. Project. Behind the scenes he is active as a composer/arranger, audio engineer and producer. Kevin is an alumn of many upstate NY bands including Alex Torres and The Latin Kings Orchestra, Jay & The Americans, The Groove Syndicate, The Refrigerators, The Joey Thomas Big Band, and Out of Control. She has conducted All-County Elementary Chorus for Rensselaer County and Greene County, as well as being a clinician for many years in Recorder and Orff for the Ulster County Young Music Symposium. She has conducted an annual Elementary All-District Music Festival in North Colonie for 10 years.

Adam Streeter is currently in his 11th year as band director at Maple Hill Middle School in Schodack. He teaches instrumental lessons for grades five through eight, directs the 5th, 6th, 7th & 8th grade concert bands, as well as the extracurricular jazz band and drama club pit band.
