NOTES ON CONDUCTORS

-JAZZ ENSEMBLE -

DAVID HAWTHORNE has been the high school band director at his alma mater Oneida City School District for the last 33 years. While at Oneida, he has been the leader of the Concert Band, Wind Ensemble, Jazz Band and the Marching Band. His bands have performed in the Outback Bowl, Indianapolis 500 parade and the Kentucky Derby parade. He currently is the director of the largest scholastic jazz festival in NY and has brought in clinicians from Maynard Fergusons band, The County Basie Orchestra and much more.

Throughout his career he has been involved with pageantry arts, having worked with the Empire Statesmen and the Rochester Crusaders. While with Empire he presented a brass clinic at the World Music Conference held in Kerkrade, the Netherlands.

For the last 6 years he has been director and the founder of the Central Winds Jazz Ensemble, a jazz group made up of educators and performers from all over the state. This past June, this group performed in jazz festivals in Rome and Venice, performing at the Colosseum and in Venice square. His is currently finishing up his final year, retiring in June. He then plans to obtain his private pilot's certification and move to Miami, Florida.

He currently resides in Sherill with his wife Marjorie. They have two daughters, Jessica, a freelance trombonist in Las Vegas and Morgan who is a French pastry chef in Pasadena, California.

-ELEMENTARY CHORUS-

JOHN SAMONTE is the choral director at the Shoreham-Wading River Central School District. He conducts the 6th Grade Treble Choir, the 7th & 8th Grade Chamber Choir, and directs an auditioned show choir and a tenor-bass singing group at Albert G. Prodell Middle School.

He has taught general music, choir, and orchestra at both the elementary and secondary level. John has been trained in Orff-Schulwerk, Kodály, World Music Drumming, Suzuki, and holds certifications in First Steps in Music, as well as Conversational Solfege (both Lower and Upper Levels) from the Feierabend Association for Music Education (FAME). He is currently the Past President of the Long Island American Orff-Schulwerk Association, President-Elect for the Kodály Organization of New York, Member-at-Large of the Choral Society of the Moriches, and serves on the Crane Alumni Board for SUNY Potsdam.

John earned his Bachelor of Music from the Crane School of Music in Potsdam, NY. He majored in Music Business and Music Education, with concentrations in Voice, Violin, and Special Music Education. In addition to his applied music studies, John holds a Master of Arts in Music & Music Education from Teachers College, Columbia University.

BRENDAN HOFFMAN is the choral director at Albany High School, a position he has proudly held since 2004. During his tenure the choral program has flourished, earning top ratings at NYSSMA choral festivals, establishing partnerships and collaborations with other choral programs, touring, and performing an exciting and challenging array of music for a wide variety of events. The Albanettes, an auditions women's choir, has performed for a number of high profile events, including Governor Andrew Cuomo's Inauguration in 2011, and twice at the NYS State of State Address. The Select Choir has tackled several major works, performing Faure's Requiem in a memorial concert and fundraiser for cancer research, then Carl Orff's Carmina Burana with the Empire State Youth Orchestra together with choirs from Guilderland, Shaker and Ravena-Coeymans-Selkirk, and most recently Rutter's Gloria with Texas State University Associate Choral Director Jonathan Babcock and choirs from Mount Sinai High School and Smithtown High School on Long Island.

Brendan has a bachelor's degree in music education from The Crane School of Music at SUNY Potsdam. As a clinician, Brendan has conducted several all-county choirs including Schoharie County, Greene County and Schenectady County.
