## NOTES ON CONDUCTORS

### ELEMENTARY BAND

**Lucas Christensen** finished his Bachelor's degrees in 2000 at Ithaca College where he majored in both clarinet performance and music education. A Master's degree in public administration in 2003 from SUNY Albany rounded out his formal schooling. He is the elementary band teacher in Chatham and is the current president of the Columbia County Music Educator's Association. In addition to being a certified NYSSMA adjudicator, Mr. Christiansen maintains a private lesson studio and has been a guest conductor in Columbia, Rensselaer and Berkshire counties for both all county bands and musical theatre productions. He has played clarinet and saxophone and flute with the Joey Thomas Big Band, the Union Symphony Orchestra and too many high and middle school musicals to count. Mr. Christensen has had a really wonderful time directing this year's Rensselaer County 5th and 6th grade band.

### JUNIOR CHORUS

**Andrea Ellison** is a general and vocal music educator working with all ages of students from prekindergarten to senior high in Parishville-Hopkinton Central School, located near the Adirondacks. Her teaching responsibilities include general music classes for grades pre-K through sixth, five choral ensembles, various high school electives and direction of the school theater program.

Mrs. Ellison received her Bachelor's of Music Education from the Crane School of Music at SUNY Potsdam and her Master's of Science in Education in Elementary Education from the same institution. She is currently in the dissertation phase of a Doctorate in Music Education through Boston University.

Mrs. Ellison resides in Potsdam, NY with her husband, Sean, and her four children, Michael, Julia, Madeleine and Jonathan.

## Notes on Conductors (continued)

### ORCHESTRA

**Brian Austin** is in his twenty third year of teaching in the North Colonie School District, 18 of those at the Junior High level and the past 5 with the Shaker High School Symphonic Orchestra. Brian received a Bachelor of Music Education from the Crane School of Music and a Masters in Education from SUNY Albany.

As an educator, Brian has been very active in the field of Music Technology, pioneering a course at Shaker High in that subject.

As conductor of the Shaker High School Symphonic Orchestra, Mr. Austin's groups have received the highest honor at NYSSMA Majors, performing at level 6 with a rating of Gold with Distinction. The orchestra has also traveled on numerous occasions to perform and have received highest commendations from adjudicators at those festivals.

### JAZZ CHORUS

**Mrs. McCaughin** holds a dual certification in both Elementary Education and Music. She received her undergraduate degree at SUNY Oneonta, and did graduate work at SUNY Albany and the Crane School of Music at SUNY Potsdam. She taught at Hoosick Falls Central School for 31 years, teaching both classroom as well as elementary music. The Swing Choir in the high school was under her direction taking them to many venues including NYSSMA competition. Previously she was the Swing Choir director at All County. For 25 years she was the drama club director, putting on more than 60 plays and musicals. Some of her students have gone on in the field of music including several music teachers and one person working on Broadway. After leaving Hoosick Falls Central School she was an adjunct professor at Russell Sage.

Now retired, she is pleased to return to All County as the Swing Choir director once again.

### SENIOR BAND

**Mr. Dan Chouiniere** is an instrumental music teacher at Shaker Junior High in the North Colonie Central School District where he conducts a grade 8 level band, a 7/8 Select Band, Percussion and various other ensembles. In his twenty-two years of experience, he has also served as a Board Member and Regional Representative for the New York State Band Directors' Association, as well as serving as the Middle School Honor Band Chairperson for three years while on the Board. Prior to serving on the NYSBDA Board, he was the percussion coach for the NYSBDA High School Honor Band. He has directed the Empire State Youth Orchestra's Junior Percussion Ensemble and worked on the audition committee for all the ESYO percussion ensembles. He has conducted All-County festivals in Saratoga, Greene, Washington, and Montgomery counties and presented teaching clinics at the Capital Area School District Association's annual symposium and the New York State School Music Association's Summer Music Conference.

Mr. Chouiniere is a graduate of the college of St. Rose where he received a BS in Music and a MS in Music Education. He currently lives in Halfmoon, NY, with his wife Sue and their many pets.
