

NOTES ON CONDUCTORS

ELEMENTARY BAND

Mr. Christopher R. Rowlands is a music educator in the Capital Region as well as a percussionist in various local area performance groups. He has an Associates degree in Music from Onondaga Community College and a Masters degree in Music Education from the College of Saint Rose. Mr. Rowlands also pursued studies at The College of Saint Rose in both Music Technology and Music Business.

Mr. Rowlands currently teaches Elementary Instrumental Music in Lansingburgh Central School District. He directs two Elementary bands, two Elementary Rock bands, a Percussion Ensemble, and the school's Drama Club. Mr. Rowlands also holds a position at the Emma Willard School for Girls in Troy as instructor of the Jazz Ensemble as well as a private studio of approximately ten students. He has conducted several All-County festivals throughout the state, including Rensselaer, Fulton-Montgomery, and now Columbia counties.

Mr. Rowlands has had the pleasure of working with several talented musicians and groups over the years. He has been the timpanist for the Capital Region Wind Ensemble and the Utica Chamber Orchestra. He has played percussion in the Onondaga County Music Educators Wind Ensemble, The Diane Marlowe Big Band, Capital Brass, and several musical theatre productions throughout the area. Mr. Rowlands spends his spare time performing with local area party bands, such as Vehicle and Jericho Joe.

JUNIOR CHORUS

Ambigay Yudkoff is a South African with extensive teaching experience and certifications in both Music and English. She is currently the Chorus Director, in her third year, at the Hoosick Falls Central School District. Since coming to the United States in August 2002, she has completed her core curriculum for the Ph. D program in Music Education at UMass/Amherst, where she taught courses in World Music, and in Junior Writing. Ambigay is currently completing her Post-Master's Advanced Certificate in Educational Leadership through Stony Brook University. She has contributed to several music conferences over the years. One of her most significant paper presentations was at the International Society for Music Education held in Bologna, Italy in July 2008. Ambigay lives with her husband, Charles, and with her three children in Saratoga County.

JAZZ CHORUS

Dr. Michael Levi is Associate Professor of Music at the College of St. Rose in Albany, New York, where he directs the Chamber Singers, teaches graduate and undergraduate courses in Music Theory, Music History, Music Education, Jazz Studies and supervises student teachers. He has also taught in the Williamsville and Depew Public School Districts near Buffalo, New York. He holds a B.A. in Music Theory from Fredonia State College, and an M.A. in Composition and Ph.D. in Music Education from the University at Buffalo. He has served on the Artistic Faculty and Administrative Staff of the New York State Summer School of the Arts in Choral Studies.

Active as a guest conductor and clinician, Dr. Levi's compositions and arrangements have been published by: Alliance Music, CPP Belwin, E. C. Schirmer, E. Henry David, BriLee Music, Lawson-Gould and Northfield Press. In addition, Dr. Levi serves a consultant to the College Board in the Advanced Placement program, conducting workshops and summer institutes for high school music teachers. He was co-editor of the Vertical Teams in the Arts: Music Theory publication.

Dr. Levi has been an active member of the New York State School Music Association. In addition to NYSSMA, he is also a member of the Music Educators National Conference, American Choral Directors Association, International Association of Jazz Educators, College Music Society and the New York State Choral Directors Guild.

SENIOR BAND

Dr. Robert S. Hansbrough is Professor of Music and Assistant Department Chair at The College of Saint Rose in Albany, New York. His teaching responsibilities include conducting the wind ensemble and chamber winds as well as graduate courses in music education, instrumental conducting and wind band literature. Additionally, he conducts The Empire State Youth Wind Orchestra. He currently serves on the National Band Association Board of Directors as the Eastern Division Chair. He earned a BA in Music Education from The University of South Florida and the Masters and Ph.D in Music Education with a concentration in wind band conducting from The Florida State University. Prior to The Saint Rose appointment, he served for four years on the faculty of Western Kentucky University as Associate Director of Bands and Director of The "Big Red" marching band. He taught for fifteen years in the Florida Public school systems. For twelve years he was Director of Bands at Lincoln HS in Tallahassee where his bands consistently earned "Superior" ratings at The FBA District and State Festival Evaluations and performed at various invitational conferences.

Dr. Hansbrough has received national recognition for excellence in teaching and conducting from the National MENC, The Kentucky Music Educators Association, FMEA, ASBDA, NBA, and the New York State School Music Association. During the last seven years of his tenure at LHS he served as Coordinator of Instrumental Music for Leon County's 37 schools. He has conducted honor bands throughout The United States and Europe and has adjudicated bands and orchestras from 26 states, Canada and Mexico. He holds professional memberships in MENC, NYSBDA, NYSSMA, NBA, CBDNA, Phi Mu Alpha, Pi Kappa Lambda, Kappa Kappa Psi, Phi Beta Mu and is an Associate Member of The Florida Bandmasters Association.

Dr. Hansbrough is married to Dr. Yvonne Chavez Hansbrough and they have one son, Esteban, who is 11.
